Reminder: Feb 21st Comment Deadline The ATV Strategic Master Plan It's out for public comment to the DNR.

There are three OHV Strategic Master Plans now in the public comment period with the Minnesota DNR, for ATVs, OHMs and ORVs. These DNR plans have been years in the making, working in partnership with all three OHV State Associations. They are intended to be guiding documents for OHV recreation across all sectors and geographic areas in Minnesota. The ATV Strategic Master Plan is part


history lesson on ATV riding in Minnesota, a close look at the the current state of ATV trails, the possibilities for future trails and much more.

It's also 107 pages long.

To help ATV MN members and member clubs get a handle on the ATV Strategic Master Plan and how to comment on it, we asked Ron Potter, ATV MN president, to give us his perspective. We also asked Perry May, ATV grant manager with the Over The Hills Gang, and who was instrumental in getting the Master Plan created and funded, for his initial comments.
